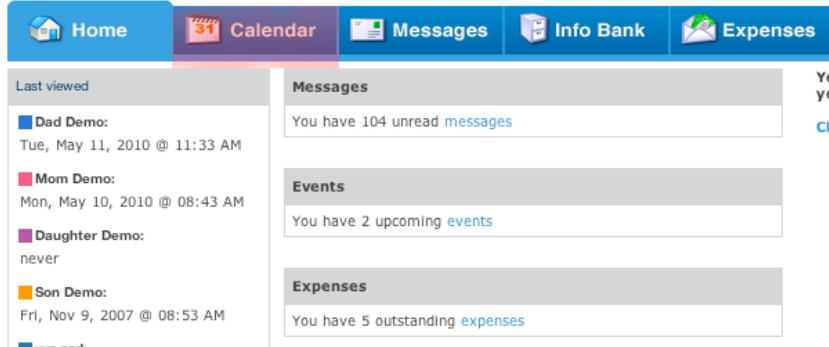
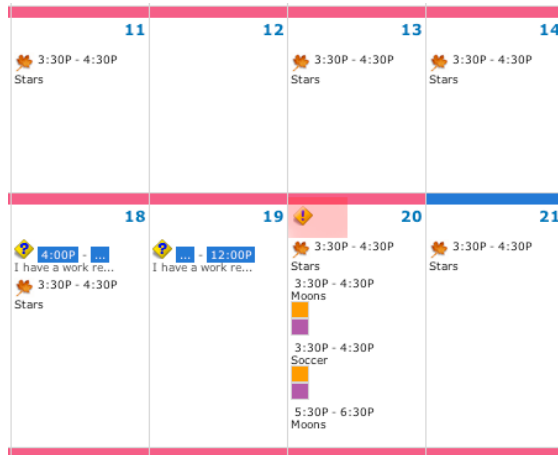


How do I resolve a scheduling conflict denoted by “!”?

If you schedule two or more things at the same time, the Our Family Wizard calendar will let you know with by placing a “!” on the calendar date and will also send you a message to be sure you don’t miss it. To resolve it you must first go to the calendar.



1. Once you are in the calendar look for the “!” on the date you have a conflict and double click on the exclamation point icon.



2. You will see an expanded view of the date in question with all of the different events for that day. Select the event you wish to edit/delete by clicking “edit” link or the “delete” link. **You can only edit/delete events that you have input.**


