

LONG DISTANCE PARENTING TIME:

If the parents live in different states, the Father shall be entitled to visit with the minor children as follows. In any given month, the Father can visit with the children in _____ on any three-day weekend (referred to as “long weekend”) when the children do not have school on a Friday or Monday. This will be limited to one long weekend a month. The Father shall give the Mother a minimum of thirty days prior notice if he intends to exercise his long weekend in any given month. If there is a holiday of three days or more that the Father is entitled to in any given month (as defined below), the Father will only be entitled to the holiday visitation which will be in place of a long weekend.

LOCAL PARENTING TIME:

If the parents live in the same state, the Father shall be entitled to every other weekend with the minor children from 6:00 p.m. on Friday until 6:00 p.m. on Sunday and Wednesday evening every week from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

This parenting schedule begins upon execution of this plan by the parties.
